Any student in physical activities takes certain inherent risks. These include, but are not limited to: sprains, bruises, pulled muscles, and broken bones. Participation in classes or lessons indicates the acceptance of such risks by students and parents/guardians. Parents/Guardians and students agree not to hold The Arts Academy or its officers, directors, staff, or employees responsible for injuries sustained or illnesses contracted by them while in attendance and/or participating in any activity related to a class, lesson, or session for personal injury or property loss.

I, the undersigned, authorize the Arts Academy to take the necessary steps regarding medical attention for injuries received while participating in a class @ The Arts Academy. I understand that our personal insurance policy covers my child for any medical costs that may be incurred while participating in any activity at the Academy. The Arts Academy is not responsible for accidents that occur before, during, and/or after class.

All students must be fully registered before accepted into class. There are NO refunds, credits, or deductions. Once a student begins, registration fee, and/or monthly tuition is non-refundable. Tuition for the month is due the first week, and a late fee of \$15 will be assessed after the 8th day of the each month. There will be a \$30 return check fee. If more than two (2) checks are returned, all future payments must be made in cash/money order/Visa/MasterCard or draft. Tuition will remain the same regardless of absences, and whether it is a long 5-week month or a short 3-week month. Any changes to schedules need to be made 24 hours before your scheduled class time. We will make every effort to reschedule missed lessons and classes. If you fail to notify us of changes, you will be charged full payment for the missed private lesson due at the next scheduled session. When registering for Arts Academy classes, you are agreeing to pay August – May tuition on a monthly basis. If you should choose to drop a class after registration is complete, you are still liable for monthly tuition and any other fees that are due during the calendar year. If not paid, a collection agency will be used at that point. Registration Fee: \$25

Students are required to wear appropriate clothing for the activity in which they are being instructed. For Ballet, Tap, Pointe, Modern and Lyrical dance classes, students should wear a leotard, tights, and the appropriate shoes. Hip Hop and Pompon classes may wear loose fitting shorts/pants. Jazz and Acro students should wear leotards, tights, and/or jazz pants. Vocal Motion and Drama students must wear exercise clothing with appropriate shoes. **NO JEANS ALLOWED IN CLASSES.**

All classes will start on time whether a student has arrived or not. Please be prompt in picking up your child after class. Students will not be allowed to leave the premises unless picked up by a parent. All students are to stay inside the building.

Every student is expected to conform to the rules and be courteous, disciplined, and respectful of ALL students and staff. We reserve the right to dismiss anyone who displays attitude, poor attendance, or conduct that is unsatisfactory. Any violation of these rules may result in dismissal from The Arts Academy.
